EXCEPTIONALITY MEASURES



MAXIMUM VOLUME OF WATER PER INHABITANT PER DAY


The volumes delivered for population supply cannot exceed a maximum equivalent allocation of 159 liters per inhabitant per day, including fractions served from municipal own resources.



SWIMMING POOLS

- The partial refilling of swimming pools that have a water recirculation system, in the quantities necessary to guarantee the sanitary quality of the water.
- In educational centers, the complete or partial filling of removable swimming pools with a capacity of less than 500 liters intended for children's swimming.

*These limitations do not apply to seawater swimming pools that are filled and emptied without connection to the public supply and sanitation networks.



IRRIGATION – Green areas and public and private gardens

- The use of water for irrigation is prohibited, except for survival watering of trees or plants. This survival irrigation must be carried out with the minimum amount of essential water, 8pm to 8am, and only by means of drip irrigation or watering can.
- Lawn irrigation is prohibited in all cases, except on surfaces intended for the federated practice of sport.
- The irrigation prohibition in exceptional cases does not apply to irrigation with rainwater collected on roofs or to irrigation with regenerated water from purifier



ORNAMENTAL SOURCES

The total or partial filling of ornamental fountains, artificial lakes and other elements of aesthetic use of water is prohibited. In artificial lakes that provide vital support for aquatic life, the minimum use of water essential for its maintenance is allowed.

CLEANING of vehicles



- Cleaning in commercial establishments dedicated to this activity that have water recirculation systems.
- Outside commercial establishments, the cleaning of glass, mirrors, rear-view mirrors, lights and license plates is only permitted using a sponge and bucket.
- The cleaning of vehicles outside commercial establishments is also allowed if it is necessary to maintain the safety and health of people and animals. This category includes food transport vehicles, animal transport (live or dead), ambulances, medical vehicles and medicine transport, as well as waste transport vehicles. In any case, cleaning will be done with the minimum possible use of water.

CLEANING of streets and urban furniture



- The cleaning with potable water of streets, sewers, pavements, facades and the like, whether public or private, is prohibited unless the cleaning is the result of an accident or a fire, or there is a health risk or a risk to the road safety. In these circumstances, cleaning will be done with the minimum amount of water necessary. Cleaning shop windows and windows with a bucket and sponge is excluded from the ban.

FARMS



The use on farms of water from the drinking water supply network is limited to the amounts necessary for watering and cleaning the animals, as well as for cleaning the premises. For this last use, it is necessary to use only the quantities essential to maintain sanitary conditions and only in the event that an alternative source is not available and exclusively through pressure cleaning systems or others of equivalent effectiveness.



DUST IN THE AIR

The use of water for the removal of dust and suspended matter in the air is prohibited.
